

2006 Election Results

Two Incumbents, Two New Board Members Elected

TOC's membership re-elected Martin Bach and Mace Siegel, and voted to add new Board members Madeline Auerbach and Harry Pellman.

The new Board took office on July 1st.



Madeline Auerbach

Auerbach became involved in horseracing 30 years ago with her late husband, James. Upon venturing into the breeding business in 1998 with their horse Unusual Heat, they had a successful line of runners, including Frankie Eyelashes, Tucked Away, Thermal Ablation, and Lennyfrommalibu. She has lived in Southern California for more than 40 years, where she raised three children and ran a successful wholesale furniture manufacturing business.

Bach, a Northern Californian, joined the TOC Board in 2003 and serves as finance chairman and treasurer. He has owned racehorses for more than 35 years and presently races, breeds and sells Thoroughbreds. He currently owns 15 horses. A senior vice president of investments at Morgan Stanley, Bach is married and has two children.

Pellman has organized and been the driving force behind a small group of friends owning racehorses for over 25 years. A practicing pediatrician in a small multi-specialty medical group that is also involved in pharmacologic research, he is married with five daughters. A past ad hoc member of the TOC Medication Committee, he brings a scientific viewpoint to the issues of medication and equine safety.

A founding member of TOC, Siegel is currently board vice chairman. With daughter Samantha, he owns Jay Em Ess Stable, campaigning undefeated Declan's Moon, winner of the Eclipse Award as best two-year-old colt of 2004. He is founder and chairman of the board of The Macerich Company, a REIT that owns, manages, leases, develops and redevelops regional mall shopping centers.

An annual election is held to fill four of the 15 Board seats, based on a staggered term structure. This year, there were eight candidates for the four seats. TOC bylaws require that at least three of the 12 owner-category board members be Northern Californians. This requirement was satisfied with the election of Bach.
